CSX scheduled to repair crossing on U.S. 90 in Baldwin next week

Baldwin – CSX is scheduled to complete repairs to the railroad crossing on U.S. 90 between U.S. 301 and Center Street in Baldwin, Florida starting Tuesday, August 21 through Wednesday, August 22. To safely complete the repairs, lane closures will be implemented each day from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

Law enforcement will be on-site for traffic control and motorists are encouraged to stay within the limits of orange cones and barrels.
