Channel Restrictions on Dunn's Creek Set Next Week for Bridge Work

November 19 through November 25

Palatka, Fla. – As part of the U.S. 17 widening project from Horse Landing Road to the north approach of the Dunn's Creek Bridge, Dunn's Creek channel restrictions will be in place Tuesday, November 19 through Wednesday, November 25 to set beams for the new bridge.


• Tuesday, November 19 through Thursday, November 21:

The channel will be closed all day. Beams will be suspended overhead and may pose a risk to the safety of the boating public if they attempt to transit through the channel. Barge workers will be monitoring VHF-FM channel 16 and 13.

• Friday, November 22 through Monday, November 25:

The horizontal bridge clearance will be reduced by 50 percent to safely stage equipment and perform work. Barge workers will be monitoring VHF-FM channel 16 and 13.

GLF Construction began the \$36.5 million widening project in February 2018 and is expected to complete construction by summer 2021, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
