Dames Point Bridge will see outside lane closures through next week

Jacksonville – Both the north and southbound lanes of Jacksonville’s Dames Point Bridge will experience single outside lane closures that will remain in place both day and night until May 18.

The lane closures are necessary to complete bridge repairs associated with the rehabilitation project. This is the last work that will require lane closures associated with this project, weather and schedule permitting.

Signs will alert drivers of the lane closures and remain in place throughout the duration of the closures.

M & J Construction of Tarpon Springs was awarded the \$4.5 million project. Construction is expected to be completed by the end of the month, weather and schedule permitting.

The Napoleon Bonaparte Broward Bridge (Dames Point Bridge) is part of I-295 East and boasts the longest span of any bridge in Florida. The Dames Point Bridge serves an important role in supporting JaxPort and connecting North Jacksonville with the Arlington area. Approximately 72,000 vehicles cross the bridge every day.
