Daytime Pedestrian Detours Planned Next Week on State Road 5A

St. Augustine, Fla – Sidewalk closures will be in place on State Road 5A/A1A (Avenida Menendez) between the Castillo de San Marcos Fort and the Bridge of Lions to complete drainage work Monday, July 29 through Wednesday, July 31 as part of resurfacing improvements on State Road 5A in downtown St. Augustine from King Street to State Road 16.

The multi-use path and sidewalk on the east side of State Road 5A will be temporarily closed each day from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. Pedestrian traffic will be rerouted to the sidewalk on the west side of the street.

Some on-street parking just north of the Bridge of Lions to the mid-block crossing at the Hilton Historic Bayfront will be restricted while drainage work is being performed in this area and will be available for use after 6 p.m.

Duval Asphalt Inc. is expected to complete the \$1.8 million resurfacing project this summer, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
