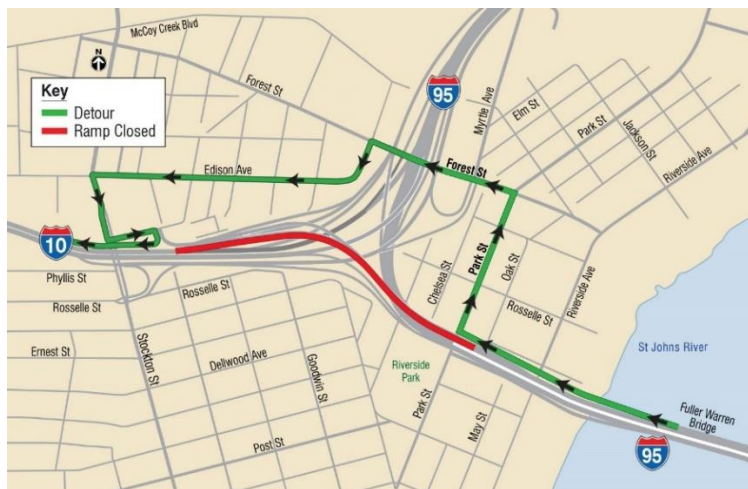

## Detour Planned for I-95 North to I-10 Flyover

**Jacksonville, Fla.** – As part of bridge construction activities for the Florida Department of Transportation’s I-10/I-95 Operational Improvements project, the I-95 north to I-10 flyover will see overnight detours beginning Monday, August 24 at 10 p.m. until 6 a.m. Tuesday, pending weather and unforeseen circumstances. I-95 north will remain open.

**I-95 north to I-10 west:** Drivers on I-95 north who wish to take I-10 west will be detoured to the Park Street exit. At the bottom of the ramp, drivers will turn right onto Park Street, left onto Forest Street, left on Edison Avenue, left on Stockton Street and left on Irene Street to access the I-10 west ramp (See map below).

**Alternate route for truckers:** Truckers traveling on I-95 north who wish to take I-10 west are advised to take an alternate route by using the I-295 West Beltway toward Orange Park and the I-10/I-295 West Beltway interchange.



FDOT hired Archer Western to complete this \$126 million project in spring 2021, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
