Detour Planned for the I-10 West Exit to Roosevelt Boulevard Sunday, March 20

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of FDOT's I-10 from I-295 to I-95 widening project, the I-10 west exit to Roosevelt Boulevard (U.S. 17) will be detoured Sunday, March 20 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. while crews perform bridge construction operations, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

<u>D</u>rivers who wish to take the Roosevelt Boulevard (U.S. 17) exit will be detoured to the McDuff Avenue exit and left on McDuff to reconnect with U.S. 17.

FDOT hired Superior Construction to complete this \$174.5 million project in early 2025, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
