## Detours Planned for Next Week at the I-10/I-95 Interchange Improvements Project

**JACKSONVILLE, Fla.** – As part of bridge construction activities for the Florida Department of Transportation's I-10/I-95 Operational Improvements project, there will be overnight detours around the I-10/I-95 interchange next week, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

<u>I-95 North Detour:</u> Sunday, Nov. 20 from 10:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., drivers on I-95 north will be detoured to the Acosta Bridge, right on Broad Street and left on Adams Street to reconnect with I-95 north. Drivers who wish to connect with I-10 will take I-95 south to connect with I-10.

<u>I-10 East Detour:</u> Monday, Nov. 21 from 10:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., drivers on I-10 east who wish to access I-95 south will be detoured north to the Union Street exit, right on Jefferson Street to connect with the Acosta Bridge and rejoin I-95 southbound.

FDOT hired Archer Western to complete this \$126 million project in fall 2022, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

The holidays are approaching. As traffic increases, let's remember to be courteous drivers. Obey all posted speed limits, never drive impaired or distracted, be patient (no road rage) and always buckle up!
