Detours Scheduled for Next Week as Part of FDOT's I-10 Widening Project

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of FDOT's I-10 from I-295 to I-95 widening project, detours are scheduled at interchanges within the project limits from Sunday, Jan. 15 through Thursday, Jan. 19 while crews perform bridge construction and drainage construction operations, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

<u>I-10 West Exit to U.S. 17 (Roosevelt Boulevard)</u>: Sunday, Jan. 15 through Thursday, Jan. 19 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., drivers will be detoured to the McDuff Avenue exit and left on McDuff Avenue to connect with Roosevelt Boulevard.

Luna Street Detour: Monday, Jan. 16 and Tuesday, Jan. 17 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Luna Street will be closed at I-10. Drivers will be detoured via Highway Avenue to Edgewood Avenue to Lenox Avenue to reconnect with Luna Street or via Lenox Avenue to Edgewood Avenue to Highway Avenue to reconnect with Luna Street.

I-10 East Exit to I-295: Tuesday, Jan. 17 and Wednesday, Jan. 18 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., drivers on I-10 east who wish to take the I-295 off-ramp will continue on I-10 east, take the Lane Avenue exit, turn left on Lane Avenue, turn left onto the I-10 west on-ramp and continue to I-295.

<u>I-10 West Off-Ramp to Cassat Avenue:</u> Tuesday, Jan. 17 and Wednesday, Jan. 18 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., drivers will be detoured to the Lane Avenue exit, right on Lane Avenue and right on Highway Avenue to connect with Cassat Avenue.

FDOT hired Superior Construction to complete this \$174.5 million project in early 2025, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
