### **Detours Scheduled for Next Week as Part of FDOT's I-10 Widening Project**

**JACKSONVILLE, Fla.** – As part of FDOT's I-10 from I-295 to I-95 widening project, detours are scheduled at interchanges within the project limits from Sunday, Aug. 20 through Thursday, Aug. 24 while crews perform bridge construction operations, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

**I-10 West Exit to U.S. 17 (Roosevelt Boulevard) closed:** Sunday, Aug. 20 through Thursday, Aug. 24 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., drivers will detour to the McDuff Avenue exit and left on McDuff Avenue to connect with Roosevelt Boulevard.

**I-10 East Exit to I-295 closed:** Sunday, Aug. 20 through Thursday, Aug. 24 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., drivers will continue on I-10 east, take the Lane Avenue exit, turn right on Lane Avenue and turn right on Normandy Boulevard to connect with I-295.

**McDuff Avenue at I-10 closed:** Sunday, Aug. 20 through Thursday, Aug. 24 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., northbound McDuff Avenue will detour right on Rosselle Street, left on Stockton Street and left on Edison Avenue to reconnect McDuff Avenue.

**Cassat Avenue closed:** Sunday, Aug. 20 through Thursday, Aug. 24 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., northbound drivers will detour right on Lenox Avenue, left on Edgewood Avenue and left on Highway Avenue to reconnect with Cassat Avenue. Southbound drivers will turn right on Highway Avenue, left on Lane Avenue and left on Normandy Boulevard to reconnect with Cassat Avenue.

**U.S. 17 North (Roosevelt Boulevard) Ramp to I-10 East closed:** Tuesday, Aug. 22 and Wednesday, Aug. 23 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., drivers will detour to Edgewood Avenue, left on Edgewood Avenue, right on Plymouth Street and left on McDuff Avenue to connect with I-10.

FDOT hired Superior Construction to complete this \$174.5 million project in early 2025, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
