Detours and Traffic Pacing Operations Planned for Next Week at the I-10 Widening Project

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of FDOT's I-10 from I-295 to I-95 widening project, I-10 west will be detoured and I-10 east will see traffic pacing operations next week while crews perform overhead sign work, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

<u>I-10 West to Roosevelt Boulevard Detour:</u> Wednesday, March 2 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., drivers who wish to take the Roosevelt Boulevard (U.S. 17) exit will be detoured to the McDuff Avenue exit and left on McDuff to reconnect with U.S. 17.

<u>I-10 West Approaching Cassat Avenue Detour:</u> Thursday, March 3 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., drivers will be detoured at the Cassat Avenue exit, left on Cassat Avenue, right on Normandy Boulevard and right on Lane Avenue to reconnect with I-10.

<u>I-10 East Pacing Operations:</u> Thursday, March 3 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., drivers can expect increased traffic between Chaffee Road and Lane Avenue due to traffic pacing operations. Drivers can also expect to see law enforcement assisting with these operations.

FDOT hired Superior Construction to complete this \$174.5 million project in early 2025, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
