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Detours scheduled next week for State Road 9B construction

St. Johns County – Nightly detours are scheduled for State Road 9B extension construction work starting Sunday, May 6 through Thursday, May 10 for overhead sign installations, schedule and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

Southbound State Road 9B traffic will detour Sunday, May 6 through Tuesday May 8 each night from midnight to 5 a.m. Traffic will detour north on U.S. 1, travel west on Old St. Augustine Road and travel to I-95 (map 1).

Southbound St. Johns Parkway/County Road 2209 traffic will detour Wednesday, May 9 and Thursday, May 10 each night from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. Traffic will detour east on Russell Sampson Road and west on County Road 210. Northbound traffic will detour east on County Road 210 and north on Russell Sampson Road (map 2).

State Road 9B, the new four-lane divided highway, will connect I-95 in Duval County to St. Johns Parkway/County Road 2209 in St. Johns County. The project includes overpasses at Race Track Road, Durbin Creek and Russell Sampson Road and a connector road, Peyton Parkway, from Race Track Road to State Road 9B. The connector road will provide direct access to State Road 9B.


