Detours starting Sunday on Kings and New Kings roads for concrete work

Jacksonville – As part of the Kings Road (S.R.15) resurfacing improvements from Cleveland Street to Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway (MLK), detours will be in place for motorists traveling on Kings Road at New Kings Road to complete concrete work starting Sunday, June 10 at 8 a.m. through Wednesday, June 20, unforeseen circumstances and weather permitting.

Motorists wanting to travel south on New Kings Road at Kings Road (railroad bridge) will instead detour to U.S. 1 then travel south on Division Street to Kings Road.

Motorists wanting to travel north on Kings Road at New Kings Road (railroad bridge) will instead detour to Division Street to MLK to New Kings Road.

Detours will alternate from one direction of travel to another within the scheduled timeframe. However, north and south detours will not be implemented at the same time.

Hubbard Construction Company began the \$5.7 million improvements in late August 2017. The project is scheduled for completion in late summer 2018, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
