Edgewood Avenue from New Kings Road to Old Kings Road resurfacing starting soon

Jacksonville – The Florida Department of Transportation will resurface and improve one mile of Edgewood Avenue (State Road 111) from New Kings Road (U.S. 1) to Old Kings Road starting in early June.

The project includes resurfacing, road base work, replacement of the curb-and-gutter on the north side of Edgewood Avenue, JEA street light improvements, traffic signal upgrades at Ina Street and Old Kings Road, pedestrian countdown timer upgrades and adding guardrails at the south approach of the railroad overpass.

Construction will occur weekdays and weeknights with some occasional weekend work. No lane closures are allowed from 6:30 to 8:30 a.m. and from 4 to 6 p.m. Monday through Friday.

In mid-June, a temporary cement barrier wall will be installed on the north side of Edgewood Avenue to allow for the removal of the existing curb-and-gutter and its replacement. The southbound outside lane of Edgewood Avenue will remain closed for several weeks during this first phase of construction while the curb-and-gutter is removed and replaced.

The \$1.1 million project is scheduled for completion in late 2017, schedule and weather permitting. Duval Asphalt Products, Inc. is the contractor.
