Edison Avenue Bridge at McCoys Creek detour


JACKSONVILLE – Motorists can expect a detour along Edison Avenue Bridge at McCoys Creek as construction to expand lanes on the bridge began September 27. The detour will start on October 17 and remain in place for approximately three months, weather permitting.

Motorists traveling southbound on Cherokee Street will still be able to make a right turn or westbound onto Edison Avenue however, motorists wanting to turn left or travel eastbound onto Edison Avenue will need to take McDuff Avenue northbound and make a right onto Fitzgerald Street eastbound and take a right onto Sunshine Street southbound to reconnect with Edison Avenue. Traffic traveling north on Lenox Avenue to Cherokee Street or eastbound on Edison Avenue will also be detoured. Please see attached map for detour details.

The Edison Avenue at McCoys Creek Bridge project is expected to be completed in winter 2019.

FDOT hired GDB-US Constructors, Inc. as the contractor to complete this project for \$3 million.
