

Ellis Road to be Detoured Overnight September 17

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. - As part of FDOT's project to widen I-10 from I-295 to I-95, an overnight detour of Ellis Road at I-10 will be in place Friday, September 17 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

Ellis Road Detour: Drivers will use either Ramona Boulevard or Highway Avenue and Lane Avenue to reconnect with Ellis Road. (See map below.)



FDOT hired Superior Construction to complete this \$174.5 million project in early 2025, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
