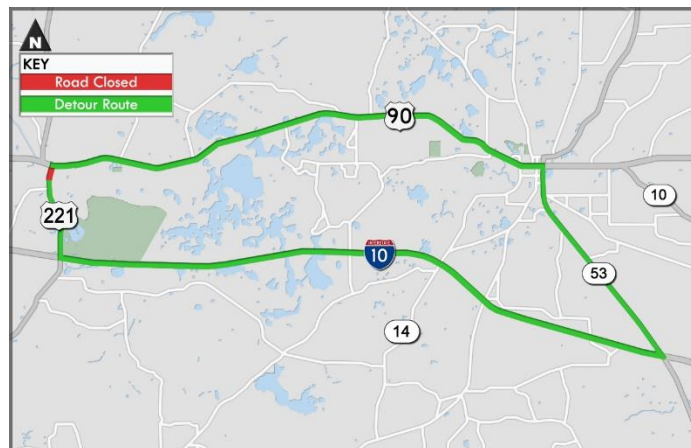

## Extended Detour Planned on U.S. 221 in Greenville

**MADISON, Fla.** – As part of a joint effort between FDOT and Florida Gulf & Atlantic Railroad to reconstruct the U.S. 221 railroad crossing in Greenville, there will be an extended detour of U.S. 221 beginning 9 a.m., Friday, August 5 until 8 p.m. Friday, August 12, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

U.S. 221 will be closed at the railroad crossing throughout the duration of the work. Heavy truck traffic should use I-10, State Road 53 (Duval Avenue) and U.S. 90 to reconnect with U.S. 221 (see map below.)
