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Pile Driving Underway on First Coast Expressway Project

Green Cove Springs, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation has started pile driving operations as part of the First Coast Expressway project in Clay County.

Construction crews have started pile driving operations on Henley Road near the Lake Asbury community to construct the future First Coast Expressway/Henley Road interchange.

Residents may experience intermittent periods of increased noise and truck traffic around the area. In order to minimize disruptions, the contractor will only perform pile driving operations from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday through Friday. Sacyr Construction began construction March 4, 2019 on the segment of the First Coast Expressway (State Road 23) from north of State Road 16 to just north of Blanding Boulevard (State Road 21) through Clay County (10.5 miles).
