FDOT to Host Sept. 22 Open House to Discuss On-Street Parking Removal on U.S. 1 in Nassau County

HILLIARD, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will host an open house next week to discuss the removal of on-street parking along U.S. 1 (State Road 15) in Nassau County as part of a future resurfacing project from Ingham Road to the Georgia state line. The informal meeting will take place both virtually and in-person Thursday, Sept. 22, from 4 to 6 p.m. at First Assembly of God located at 550920 U.S. 1, Hilliard, FL 32046.

All participants, regardless of the platform they choose, will be able to view project documents and ask questions.

The parking spaces, from south of Chapel Street to 8th Street in Hilliard and from Yellow Oak Court to Pope Drive in Boulogne, will be re-striped as buffered bicycle lanes as part of the eight-mile-long resurfacing and roadway improvement project that is scheduled to begin in fall 2023.
