FDOT to host open house for Pecan Park Road reconstruction Monday

Jacksonville – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is hosting an open house June 12 at the Hampton Inn and Suites, 13551 Airport Court, Jacksonville, Florida 32218 from 4:30 to 6:30 p.m. for a reconstruction and roadway-widening project on Pecan Park Road (S.R. 243) scheduled to begin in mid-June.

Those interested in the reconstruction project on Pecan Park Road from I-95 to east of Lexington Park Boulevard are invited to attend. Project team members and FDOT staff will be available to answer questions, discuss traffic impacts and construction activities. There will be no formal presentation.

Petticoat-Schmitt Civil Contractors Inc. is expected to complete the reconstruction work in late 2018, weather and schedule permitting.
