FDOT to host public information meeting for improvements on U.S. 301

Jacksonville – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to host a public information meeting to discuss proposed improvements on S.R. 200/U.S. 301 between I-10 and U.S. 90 (Beaver Street) in Baldwin, Florida.

The public meeting is scheduled for Thursday, May 4 at the Senior Citizens Center, located at 850 N. Center Street, Baldwin, Florida 32234. This meeting will be an 'Open House' format where interested parties may drop by any time between 4:30 - 6:30 p.m. to review project displays and talk with Department staff. There will be no formal presentation.

The FDOT is proposing to mill and resurface the roadway, update ADA facilities and remove on-street parking throughout the project to allow for the addition of buffered bikes lanes.

Public participation is solicited without regard to race, color, religion, sex, age, national origin, disability or family status as FDOT complies with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
