Hart Bridge Eastbound Closure Scheduled this Sunday

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – Both eastbound lanes of the Hart Bridge and on-ramps to the Hart Bridge from Adams Street, East Duval Street and Gator Bowl Boulevard are scheduled to close this Sunday, April 28 from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. as part of FDOT's routine bridge inspection. The directional closure is necessary for the safety of maintenance crews and motorists.

During the closure, drivers will follow a detour route to use the Mathews Bridge eastbound to University Boulevard to access Atlantic Boulevard. Drivers are encouraged to use caution during this time and follow posted detour signs.
