

## I-95 Southbound Lane from 8<sup>th</sup> Street to 5<sup>th</sup> Street Closed Overnight Sunday and Monday

**JACKSONVILLE, Fla.** – Two southbound lanes of I-95 from 8th Street to south of West 5<sup>th</sup> Street, including the 8<sup>th</sup> Street on-ramp to I-95 southbound, will close overnight Sunday and Monday, Oct. 9 and 10, from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., for thermoplastic and rumble strip installation. The work is associated with the recent repair project on the I-95 West 5<sup>th</sup> Street overpass.

For the 8th Street ramp closure, traffic will detour to either Myrtle Avenue North and Kings Road/Union Street or North Davis Steet and State Street to I-95 southbound.

Drivers may see increased traffic or congestion during peak driving hours and are encouraged to seek alternate routes.
