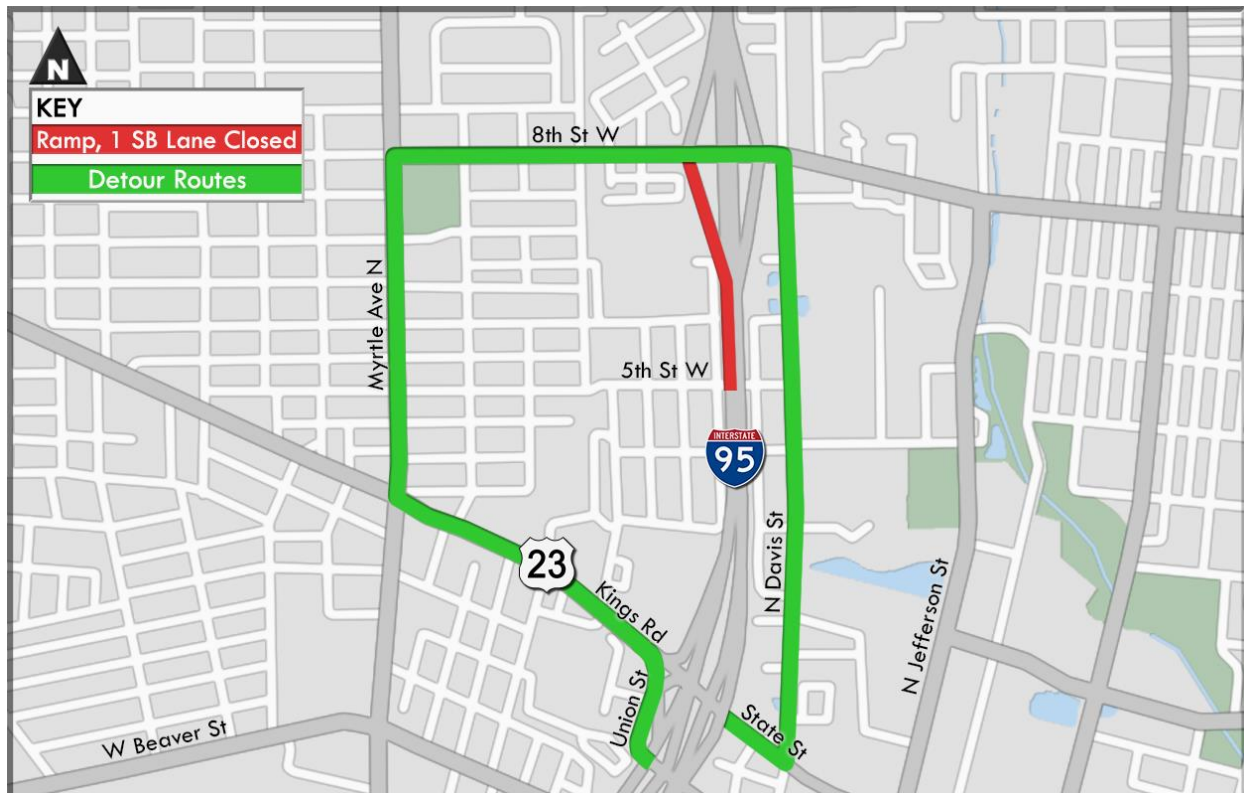

I-95 Southbound Lane from 8th Street to 5th Street Closed Temporarily Starting September 9

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – One southbound lane of I-95 from 8th Street to south of West 5th Street, including the 8th Street on-ramp to I-95 southbound, will close at approximately 10 p.m. Friday, September 9, for bridge deck repairs on the I-95 West 5th Street overpass. The closures will be in place for approximately two weeks. For the 8th Street ramp closure, traffic will detour to either Myrtle Avenue North and Kings Road/Union Street or North Davis Street and State Street to I-95 southbound.

Drivers may see increased traffic or congestion during peak driving hours and are encouraged to seek alternate routes.
