Improvements to I-295 at CSX Railroad Bridges Expected to Begin this Month

Jacksonville – Construction is expected to begin later this month on improvements to I-295 at CSX Railroad Bridges 720410 and 720411, which are located about halfway between the I-10 and Commonwealth Avenue interchanges.

The project, which is expected to begin August 20, involves construction of crash wall protection, fencing and other incidental construction. Most work is expected to take place Monday through Friday between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. with minimal impact to traffic.

Traffic will be maintained in accordance with FDOT design standards throughout the project. Occasional nighttime lane closures will be necessary on I-295 for concrete and fencing work. No lane closures will be permitted between 5 a.m. and 9 p.m. Monday through Thursday or from 5 a.m. Friday to 9 p.m. Sunday during construction. Lane closure notices will be available at www.nflroads.com.

M & J Construction of Pinellas County, Inc. is expected to complete the \$857,000 project by spring 2019, weather and schedule permitting.
