Intermittent Nighttime Closures Scheduled for Hospital Creek Bridge on State Road A1A Planned through March

ST. AUGUSTINE, Fla.- As part of the Hospital Creek Bridge improvement project located on State Road A1A just west of the Vilano Bridge, the Hospital Creek Bridge will be temporarily closed, nightly, to traffic intermittently (30 minute increments) Thursday, March 18 through Wednesday, March 31 from 9:30 p.m. to 6:30 a.m. The closures are necessary for crews to complete rehabilitation work underneath the bridge.

The bridge will reopen to allow emergency response vehicles to pass through when needed.

The improvements to the bridge include deck and joint repair work, concrete beam repairs, cathodic protection for piles and bent caps and other miscellaneous work items.

Southern Road and Bridge, LLC. is projected to complete the \$1.2 million bridge rehabilitation improvement project by late 2021. Construction project completion dates are fluid and subject to change.
