Kingsley Avenue to Close Near Doctors Lake Drive for Railroad Crossing Work

Orange Park, Florida – Kingsley Avenue will close in the immediate area of the railroad crossing located just west of Doctors Lake Drive as part of a project to replace the crossing surface. Construction is expected to begin Thursday, June 7 at 3 a.m. and is scheduled to be completed by Thursday, June 21 at 6 p.m. The roadway will reopen early if work is completed ahead of schedule or could be closed longer if there are weather or other unforeseen delays.

During the closure, traffic will be detoured via U.S. 17 (Park Avenue), Wells Road and Blanding Boulevard as seen in the map below.
