Main Street Bridge to see closure this weekend, nightly next two weeks

Jacksonville – Jacksonville's Main Street Bridge will be closed this weekend from Friday, February 16 at 6:30 p.m. to Sunday, February 18 at 6 a.m. and will close nightly the next two weeks as crews continue their work on rehabilitation of the structure.

Closures of the Main Street Bridge will follow the schedule below, as part of improvements to the mechanical, electrical and structural systems:

Monday, February 19 from 6:30 p.m. to 6 a.m. Tuesday, February 20 from 6:30 p.m. to 6 a.m. Wednesday, February 21 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. Thursday, February 22 from 6:30 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Monday, February 26 from 6:30 p.m. to 6 a.m. Tuesday, February 27 from 6:30 p.m. to 6 a.m. Wednesday, February 28 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. Thursday, March 1 from 6:30 p.m. to 6 a.m.

During closures, both vehicular and pedestrian traffic will be detoured to the Acosta Bridge. Signs will direct traffic through the detour. Boaters will not be impacted by the closures.

M & J Construction of Tarpon Springs was awarded the \$10.7 million contract. The project is expected to be completed in spring 2018.
