Maintenance Repairs to Rail Crossing on State Road 111 Planned Next Week

Jacksonville, Fla. – CSX plans to complete maintenance work on its crossing located on State Road 111/Edgewood Avenue at U.S. 90/Beaver Street from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Thursday, March 28 and Friday, March 29, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

CSX will begin maintenance work on the northbound and southbound outside travel lanes and complete the remaining work on the inside travel lanes last.

No complete road closures are scheduled for this work.
