Multiple Detours Scheduled for Next Week as Part of FDOT's I-10 Widening Project

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of FDOT's I-10 from I-295 to I-95 widening project, multiple detours are scheduled at interchanges throughout the project limits from Sunday, Dec. 18 through Thursday, Dec. 22 while crews perform bridge construction and paving operations, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

<u>I-10 West Exit to U.S. 17 (Roosevelt Boulevard):</u> Sunday, Dec. 18 through Thursday, Dec. 22 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., drivers who wish to take the Roosevelt Boulevard exit will be detoured to the McDuff Avenue exit and left on McDuff Avenue to reconnect with Roosevelt Boulevard.

<u>Luna Street Detour:</u> Sunday, Dec. 18 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Luna Street will be closed at I-10. Drivers will be detoured via Highway Avenue to Edgewood Avenue to Lenox Avenue to reconnect with Luna Street or via Lenox Avenue to Edgewood Avenue to Highway Avenue to reconnect with Luna Street.

<u>I-10 West Off-Ramp to Luna Street:</u> Sunday, Dec. 18 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., drivers will be detoured to the McDuff Avenue exit, right on McDuff Avenue and left on Highway Avenue. Drivers may also take the Cassat Avenue exit, turn right on Cassat Avenue and right on Highway Avenue to connect with Luna Street.

<u>I-10 West Off-Ramp to Cassat Avenue:</u> Tuesday, Dec. 20 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., drivers will be detoured to the Lane Avenue exit, right on Lane Avenue and right on Highway Avenue, and right on to Cassat Avenue

FDOT hired Superior Construction to complete this \$174.5 million project in early 2025, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
