Multiple Detours Planned for Next Week at the I-10/I-95 Operational Improvements Project

JACKSONVILLE, **Fla.** – As part of bridge construction activities for the Florida Department of Transportation's I-10/I-95 Operational Improvements project, detours are planned for I-95 south approaching downtown and the I-95 north to I-10 west flyover, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

<u>I-95 South</u>: Wednesday, August 4 and Thursday, August 5 from 8:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., drivers on I-95 south will be detoured at exit 352D towards I-10, continue on I-10 west and take the Luna Street exit, turn left on Luna Street, left on the I-10 east on-ramp and continue on I-10 to rejoin I-95 south.

<u>I-95 North to I-10 West:</u> Monday, August 2 from 10:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Wednesday, August 4 and Thursday, August 5 from 8:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. drivers on I-95 north who wish to take I-10 west will be detoured to the Park Street exit. At the bottom of the ramp, drivers will turn right on Park Street, left on Forest Street, left on Edison Avenue, left on Stockton Street and left on Irene Street to access the I-10 west ramp.

FDOT hired Archer Western to complete this \$126 million project in fall 2021, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
