Multiple Detours Planned for Next Week at the I-10/I-95 Interchange Improvements Project

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of bridge construction activities for the Florida Department of Transportation's I-10/I-95 Operational Improvements project, there will be multiple overnight detours around the I-10/I-95 interchange next week, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

<u>I-95 South to I-10 West Exit Ramp 351A:</u> Monday, Nov. 14 from 10:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., drivers on I-95 south who wish to connect with I-10 must take exit 352D, which is prior to exit 351A for southbound I-95 traffic.

Forest Street On-Ramp to I-10 West Detour: Monday, Nov. 14 from 10:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., drivers who wish to take the Forest Street on-ramp to I-10 will be detoured to Margaret Street/Edison Avenue, left on Claude Street/Irene Street and left at the signal to take the I-10 westbound on-ramp. Drivers who wish to take U.S. 17 (Roosevelt Boulevard) will continue on Edison Avenue and turn left on McDuff Avenue to connect with Roosevelt Boulevard.

<u>I-95 South Detour:</u> Thursday, Nov. 17 from 10:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., drivers on I-95 south will be detoured to the Forest Street exit, left on Forest Street and right on Park Street to rejoin I-95 southbound.

<u>I-10 East Detour:</u> Thursday, Nov. 17 from 10:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., drivers on I-10 east who wish to access I-95 south will be detoured north to the Union Street exit, right on Jefferson Street to connect with the Acosta Bridge and rejoin I-95 southbound.

FDOT hired Archer Western to complete this \$126 million project in fall 2022, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

The holidays are approaching. As traffic increases, let's remember to be courteous drivers. Obey all posted speed limits, never drive impaired or distracted, be patient (no road rage) and always buckle up!
