Multiple Lane Closures on Beach Boulevard Planned This Weekend

Jacksonville, Fla. – As part of the Florida Department of Transportation’s Beach Boulevard Signals Improvement Project, multiple lanes of westbound Beach Boulevard will be closed over the weekend.

Beginning Saturday, July 11 at 6 a.m. until Sunday, July 12 at 6 a.m., three lanes of westbound Beach Boulevard will be closed between Grove Park Boulevard and Palm Lane while crews perform signal work. One westbound lane of Beach Boulevard will remain open, and the intersections at Foster Drive and Palm Avenue will be controlled by law enforcement officers. Drivers should expect delays and plan their routes accordingly.

Florida Safety Contractors, Inc. is expected to complete this \$3.8 million improvement project in fall 2020, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

The Florida Department of Transportation urges motorists to always follow the speed limit and stay within the limits of orange cones and barrels while traveling through construction zones.
