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Multiple Overnight Detours Planned for I-10/I-95 Interchange Improvements Project

Jacksonville, Fla. – As part of FDOT's I-10/I-95 Operational Improvements project, multiple overnight detours are scheduled Thursday, July 24 through Saturday, August 1 for bridge construction activities, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

<u>I-95 North to I-10 Flyover Detour:</u> Thursday, July 24 through Thursday, July 30 from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., drivers using I-95 north who wish to connect to I-10 west will be detoured to the Park Street exit. At the bottom of the ramp, drivers will turn right onto Park Street, left onto Forest Street, left onto Edison Avenue, left onto Stockton Street and left onto Irene Street to access the I-10 west ramp. <u>I-95 North/I-10 West On-Ramp at Palm Avenue:</u> Tuesday, July 28 through Thursday, July 30 from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., drivers who wish to take I-95 north/I-10 west on-ramp at Palm Avenue will be detoured to San Marco Boulevard and left onto Mary Street to take the Acosta Bridge. After crossing the Acosta Bridge, drivers will turn right onto Broad Street and left onto Adams Street to connect to the I-95 north on-ramp, the I-95 south on-ramp or the I-10 west on-ramp.
