Nightly Milling and Resurfacing of Lane Avenue to Begin August 28

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of FDOT's Lane Avenue resurfacing project, milling and resurfacing of Lane Avenue between Normandy Boulevard and Wilson Boulevard will begin the night of Sunday, August 28. Work will take place nightly from 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. through the morning of Friday, September 2, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting. Nightly work will then resume on Tuesday, September 6.

Traffic will be maintained in accordance with FDOT design standards throughout the project. Drivers should expect single-lane closures, delays and uneven road surfaces due to overnight milling and resurfacing work. One lane in each direction will remain open at all times.

Anderson Columbia, Co., Inc. is expected to complete this \$7.9 million improvement project in spring 2023, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
