Nightly Ramp Detours Planned Next Week at Butler Boulevard and San Pablo Road Interchange

Jacksonville, Fla. – As part of the Florida Department of Transportation's interchange improvement project at Butler Boulevard and San Pablo Road, multiple overnight detours are planned Sunday, August 23 through Saturday, August 29.

Sunday, August 23: The ramp from San Pablo Road to westbound Butler Boulevard will be closed from 8 p.m. Sunday, August 23 until 6 a.m. Monday, August 24. Drivers will be detoured to eastbound Butler Boulevard, where they will continue to the South Beach Parkway exit and turn left onto South Beach Parkway to access the ramp onto westbound Butler Boulevard (shown in Map 1 below).

Monday, August 24: The ramp from San Pablo Road to westbound Butler Boulevard will be closed from 10 p.m. Monday, August 24 until 6 a.m. Tuesday, August 25 (see Map 1 for detour).

Additionally, the ramp from westbound Butler Boulevard to San Pablo Road will be closed from 8 p.m. Monday, August 24 until 6 a.m. Tuesday, August 25. Drivers will be detoured to Hodges Boulevard, where they can access eastbound Butler Boulevard to reach the San Pablo Road exit (shown in Map 2 below).

Tuesday, August 25: The ramp from San Pablo Road to eastbound Butler Boulevard will be closed from 8 p.m. Tuesday, August 25 until 6 a.m. Wednesday, August 26. Drivers will be detoured to westbound Butler Boulevard to the Hodges Boulevard exit, where they will be able to access eastbound Butler Boulevard (shown in Map 3 below).

Wednesday, August 26: The ramp from San Pablo Road to westbound Butler Boulevard will be closed from 8 p.m. Wednesday, August 26 until 6 a.m. Thursday, August 27 (see Map 1 for detour).

Thursday, August 27: The ramp from San Pablo Road to westbound Butler Boulevard will be closed from 8 p.m. Thursday, August 27 until 6 a.m. Friday, August 28 (see Map 1 for detour).

Friday, August 28: The ramp from San Pablo Road to eastbound Butler Boulevard will be closed from 8 p.m. Friday, August 28 until 6 a.m. Saturday, August 29 (see Map 3 for detour).

FDOT hired Watson Civil Construction to complete this \$12 million project, which includes construction of a diverging diamond interchange at San Pablo Road and Butler Boulevard, in spring of 2022, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
