


Nightly Traffic Diversions Planned for Next Week on Gate Parkway

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – Next week, Gate Parkway will see overnight diversions of eastbound and westbound traffic between Southside Boulevard and W. Deer Lake Drive while crews perform underground drainage work, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

<u>Westbound Gate Parkway Diversion:</u> Monday, April 18 and Tuesday, April 19 from 8:30 p.m. to 6:30 a.m., drivers on westbound Gate Parkway will be temporarily diverted to the opposite side of the road at W. Deer Lake Drive. Law enforcement will be on site to assist with traffic management. (See map below.)



<u>Eastbound Gate Parkway Diversion:</u> Wednesday, April 20 and Thursday, April 21 from 8:30 p.m. to 6:30 a.m., drivers on eastbound Gate Parkway will be temporarily diverted to the opposite side of the road at the Southside Boulevard intersection. Law enforcement will be on site to assist with traffic management. (See map below.)
