Nightly ramp closures scheduled next week at I-95 and Lem Turner Road

Jacksonville – As the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) continues resurfacing improvements on Lem Turner Road (S.R. 115) from I-95 to Soutel Drive, ramp closures and detours will be in place starting Sunday, June 3 through Thursday, June 7 each night from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. to safely complete construction work at the interchange.

Motorists traveling south and north on I-95 wanting to exit at Lem Turner Road (Exit 356) or Norwood Avenue (S.R. 117) will instead detour to exit at Edgewood Avenue to travel back to Lem Turner Road.

The project improvements will include removing and replacing the top layer of asphalt between I-95 and Soutel Drive, updating handicap accessible ramps, sidewalk repairs, guardrail replacement and pedestrian signal upgrades.

Preferred Materials Inc. is completing the \$4 million project by fall 2018, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
