Nighttime Detours Planned for Paving Operations on Crill Avenue Next Week

Palatka, Fla. – As part of resurfacing improvements on State Road 20/Crill Avenue from Palm Avenue to Osceola Street, State Road 20 between South Palm Avenue and Husson Avenue will be closed nightly Monday, February 10 through Friday, February 14 from 8 p.m. to 6:30 a.m. for roadway paving operations.

Motorists will detour via Mosely Avenue and St. Johns Avenue. Local thru traffic for residents within the work area will remain available.

The improvement project includes milling and paving the roadway from Palm Avenue to Osceola Street, sidewalk repairs, curb and gutter work and upgrading the traffic signals at Palm Avenue, Westover Drive, Husson Avenue and Mosely Avenue. The pedestrian flashing beacon on State Road 20 and 18th Street will also be updated.

To safely complete the work, periodic lane closures will be necessary Monday through Sunday from 8 p.m. to 6:30 a.m.

Motorists should stay alert and adhere to posted construction and regulatory signs while traveling through the active construction zone.
