Open house for New Kings Road safety project set for July 30

Jacksonville – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is hosting an informal open house Monday, July 30 at St. Paul AME Church, 6910 New Kings Road, Jacksonville, FL 32219 from 4:30 to 6:30 p.m. to display resurfacing and safety improvement plans on New Kings Road (State Road 15) from Edgewood Avenue to Trout River Boulevard.

Those interested in more information on the improvement project on New Kings Road are encouraged to attend. Project team members and FDOT staff will be available to answer questions, discuss traffic impacts and construction activities. There will be no formal presentation.

Duval Asphalt Products Inc. is expected to begin the \$10 million improvements in late September and complete the work by fall 2019, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
