Overnight Closures on I-10 between State Road 23 and U.S. 301 Scheduled March 3 and 4

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – Overnight closures of I-10 from U.S. 301 to State Road 23 (First Coast Expressway) are scheduled Wednesday, March 3 and Thursday, March 4. Westbound lanes will close from 9 p.m. to 2 a.m. and eastbound lanes will close from approximately midnight to 5 a.m. each night for work related to the Yellow Water Road Bridge replacement project.

Both detours will utilize Beaver Street (U.S. 90) via the State Road 23/First Coast Expressway ramp (westbound) and via the U.S. 301 (eastbound) ramp back to I-10 (shown in map below).
