Overnight Closures on I-10 from State Road 23 to U.S. 301 Scheduled Next Week

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – Westbound lanes of I-10 from State Road 23 (First Coast Expressway) to U.S. 301 are scheduled to close overnight Wednesday, January 13 and eastbound lanes will be closed Thursday, January 14, from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., weather permitting, for work related to the Yellow Water Road Bridge replacement project.

Both detours will utilize Beaver Street (U.S. 90) via the State Road 23 ramp (westbound) and via the U.S. 301 (eastbound) ramp back to I-10 (shown in map below).
