Overnight Detour Planned for Adams Street to I-10

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of FDOT's I-10/I-95 Operational Improvements project, there will be a detour of the Adams Street to I-10 route while crews perform roadway striping activities.

From 11 p.m. Tuesday, May 25 to 5 a.m. Wednesday, May 26, drivers merging onto I-95 south from the Adams Street on-ramp to access I-10 west will be directed to the Fuller Warren Bridge, where they can take the I-95 south to San Marco Street exit, a left on Palm Avenue and an immediate left onto I-95 north to continue to the I-10 west ramp.
