

Overnight Detour of U.S 17 Planned for I-95/I-295 North Interchange Project

Jacksonville, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation will temporarily detour traffic on U.S. 17 between Eastport Road and New Berlin Road Sunday, May 31 through Friday, June 5 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. for beam placement as part of the I-95/I-295 North Interchange Improvement Project.

As shown in the map below, drivers attempting to travel southbound on U.S. 17 will be detoured to Airport Road onto southbound I-95 to the Busch Drive exit, where they can rejoin U.S. 17. Drivers attempting to travel northbound on U.S. 17 will be detoured to Busch Drive to northbound I-95 to the Airport Road exit, where they can rejoin U.S. 17.



This work is part of the I-95/I-295 North Interchange Operational Improvement project that includes a new collector-distributor system, auxiliary lanes and ramp improvements. The interchange is part of an important corridor to promote economic growth and development in the region.

FDOT selected Archer Western to complete this \$176.8 million project in fall 2021, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
