Overnight Detours Planned Next Week at King Street and U.S. 1

ST. AUGUSTINE, Fla. – As part of the resurfacing improvements on U.S. 1 from State Road 207 to St. Augustine City Gates, a closure of the King Street/U.S. 1 intersection is necessary for concrete pavement replacement work. King Street at U.S. 1 will close nightly at 8:30 p.m. and reopen by 6:30 a.m. the following morning Sunday, Feb. 5 through Thursday, Feb 9.

During the closures, eastbound King Street drivers will be detoured via S. Dixie Highway, State Road 207 and U.S. 1 to access U.S. 1 and King Street eastbound. Westbound King Street drivers will be detoured via Malaga Street and U.S. 1 to access U.S. 1 and King Street westbound. Motorists should follow detour signs and use extra caution during the closures.

Kiewit Infrastructure South Company is estimated to complete the \$15 million resurfacing improvements by winter 2023, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
