### **Overnight Detours Planned Next Week at the State Road 207 Ramp to I-95 North**

**ST. AUGUSTINE, Fla. –** As part of resurfacing improvements on I-95 from State Road 207 to International Golf Parkway, closures of the State Road 207 on-ramp to I-95 North are necessary for widening work to be completed. The on-ramp will close nightly at 8 p.m. Sunday, April 14 and Monday, April 15 and reopen by 6 a.m. the following mornings.

During the closures, drivers on State Road 207 seeking to access I-95 North will use I-95 South and exit at State Road 206 to access I-95 North. Drivers are encouraged to use caution in the area and follow posted detour signs at this time.

Anderson Columbia Co. Inc. is estimated to complete the \$31 million resurfacing improvements by early 2025, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
