### Overnight Detours Planned Next Week for San Pablo Road Ramp to Eastbound Butler Boulevard

**JACKSONVILLE, Fla.** – As part of the Florida Department of Transportation's interchange improvement project at Butler Boulevard and San Pablo Road, overnight detours will be implemented on southbound San Pablo Road Wednesday, June 30 and Thursday, July 1 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Motorists seeking to access the ramp to eastbound Butler Boulevard will be directed south on San Pablo Road, where they will make a U-turn to access the ramp from northbound San Pablo Road.
