Overnight Detours Planned This Week for I-95 North Ramp to Westbound Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of an interchange improvement project at I-95 and Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway, ramp closures are scheduled from Monday, Oct. 30 to Friday, Nov. 3 for milling operations.

The ramp from northbound I-95 to westbound MLK will close nightly between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. During the closures, drivers will continue on northbound I-95 to the Golfair Boulevard exit and take southbound I-95 to the westbound MLK exit.
