Overnight Detours Planned at Butler Boulevard and Kernan Boulevard Interchange April 28 through May 2

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of the interchange improvement project at J.T. Butler Boulevard (State Road 202) and Kernan Boulevard, the ramp from eastbound Butler Boulevard to northbound Kernan Boulevard and the ramp from Kernan Boulevard to eastbound Butler Boulevard will close nightly Sunday, April 28 through Thursday, May 2, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting. The ramps will close at 8 p.m. each night and reopen by 5 a.m. the following morning to allow for paving activities.

During the ramp closures, the following detours will be in place:

Eastbound Butler Boulevard to northbound Kernan Boulevard closed: Drivers will take Butler Boulevard east to the Hodges Boulevard exit to access westbound Butler Boulevard and the Kernan Boulevard exit.

Kernan Boulevard to eastbound Butler Boulevard closed: Drivers will take Butler Boulevard westbound to I-295 southbound, exit at Gate Parkway and take I-295 northbound to access eastbound Butler Boulevard.

FDOT hired J.B. Coxwell Contracting to complete the \$17.1 million project, which includes construction of a partial cloverleaf interchange, adding capacity to on- and off-ramps, milling and resurfacing of existing pavement, roadway lighting improvements, construction of ponds and other drainage improvements and installation of new signage and mast arm signals. The project is expected to be completed in late 2024, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
