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Overnight Detours Planned for the I-10/I-95 Operational Improvements Project

Jacksonville – The I-10/I-95 Operational Improvements project will see overnight detours this weekend while crews remove and repaint lane lines on the I-95 south to I-10 west ramp.


<u>I-95 South to I-10 Detour:</u> May 1-3, from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m., motorists traveling on I-95 south who wish to access I-10 west will be detoured to the Forest Street exit ramp, where they will continue through the intersection at the bottom of the exit to connect with I-10 west. Law enforcement will be on site to assist with the flow of traffic. (See map below)



Adams Street On-Ramp: May 1-3, from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m., motorists merging onto I-95 south from the Adams Street on-ramp who wish to access I-10 west will be directed to the Fuller Warren Bridge, take the I-95 south to San Marco Street exit, take a left on Palm Avenue, take an immediate left onto I-95 north and continue to the I-10 west ramp.
