Overnight Detours This Week I-295 North Interchange Project

Jacksonville, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation will implement overnight detours next week as part of the I-95/I-295 North Interchange Operational Improvement project.

Monday, October 5 through Thursday, October 8:

The I-95 northbound exit ramp to Airport Road is expected to be closed from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.

As shown in the map below, drivers attempting to exit onto Airport Road will be detoured north to the Pecan Park exit onto I-95 southbound where they can access Airport Road.



I-95 Northbound to Airport Road Detour

Monday, October 5 through Thursday, October 8:

The I-295 eastbound ramp to I-95 southbound is expected to be closed from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.

As shown in the map below, drivers attempting to exit onto I-95 southbound from I-295 eastbound will be detoured to Duval Road onto Airport Road where they can access I-95 southbound.



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Tuesday, October 6:

The I-95 southbound ramp to I-295 westbound is expected to be closed from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.

As shown in the map below, drivers attempting to exit onto I-295 westbound from I-95 southbound will be detoured onto I-295 eastbound onto U.S. 17 where they can access I-295 westbound.

The I-295 eastbound ramp to I-95 northbound is expected to be closed from 10 p.m. to 5 p.m.



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As shown in the map below, drivers on I-295 eastbound attempting to exit onto I-95 northbound will be detoured to U.S. 17 and Airport Road where they can access I-95 northbound.



I-295 Eastbound to I-95 Northbound Detour

This work is part of the I-95/I-295 North Interchange Operational Improvement project that includes a new collector-distributor system, auxiliary lanes and ramp improvements. The interchange is part of an important corridor to promote economic growth and development in the region.

FDOT selected Archer Western to complete this \$176.8 million project in fall 2021, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
